2022 IN REVIEW

2022 was an amazing year of fundraising growth and community engagement for Friends of PAC. Welcoming increased visitor numbers, PAC had a great year!

- Supported PAC with **\$124,900** through grants, fundraising and private donations and equipment purchases.
- Had a successful 2nd annual Midnight on the Mesa 12-hour relay with the addition of a one-lap and FREE kids race!
- Utilized our Youth Scholarship Fund which administered \$4,300. These dollars make programs, memberships, and summer camp accessible to all youth without the burden of financial restrictions. In addition, this fund allows for DFS families to utilize PAC.
- Dedicated volunteers contributed 1422 volunteer hours and \$2,572 of in-kind donations.
- Secured grants from the Wyoming Arts Council, Wyoming Community Foundation, and Temporary Assistance for Need Families. These grants are critical support for current programs and ensure their quality and accessibility.



GRANT FUNDING SOFTENS FINANCIAL BURDEN OF CAMP TUITION Thanks to the TANF (Temporary Assistance for Need Families) grant, 13 summer day camp scholarships were offered in 2022 providing a total of \$8,975 in tuition assistance.

SUMMER DAY CAMP

Summer camp has always been a popular program but the skyrocketing demand for elementary-aged summer care surpassed all expectations. Over 100 youth attended at least one day of camp in the 2022 summer. There was also the addition of 6th grade.

PAINTING AND PLAYING UKULELES

Summer campers were given the opportunity to paint and learn how to play the Ukulele thanks to the Wyoming Arts Council grant!

LEARN TO SWIM

An essential program teaching a critical life skill, the Learn to Swim program reached 327 Sublette County children in 2022.

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Thanks to the generosity of a private donor, Friends of PAC is offering scholarships for PAC youth programs and youth memberships. Previously offered directly by PAC, Friends of PAC scholarship options provide a broader reach with the qualifying financial criteria. <u>Midnight on the Mesa</u>: The second annual all-night fundraising race was another success! Teams raced through the night on a course just South of Pinedale that provides incredible views of our mountain town. This year, the addition of Moonrise on the Mesa, a 1 lap event and Sunrise on the Mesa, a free kid's race, brought in more racers of all ages and abilities. Get ready for more glow-in-the-dark & neon fun next year on June 16 & 17, 2023 Midnight on the Mesa. This event has raised over \$40,000 with the support of our main sponsors Pure West and Union Wireless.



Swim-a-thon: Friends of PAC started 2022 with our first ever Swim-athon. Swimmers challenged themselves to complete a certain number of laps and found generous sponsors that pledged a donation for each lap. Doc Foster swam an impressive 800 laps. A huge thank you to the dedicated swimmers - all of their hours in the pool raised over \$13,500!



Open House & Art Reception: In February, in partnership with the Sublette County Centennial Celebration, Friends of PAC held an art show at the Sublette County Library highlighting recreation. The evening also featured a silent auction of original artwork made by PAC's Little Wrangler Day Camp participants. The pieces made by campers were part of a grant funded by the Wyoming Arts Council to create vibrant sound baffles for the gym. The unique event raised almost \$1,100 for Friends of PAC and demonstrated the importance of volunteer based groups supporting each other in this community.



WyoGives: The third annual state-wide day of giving is organized by the Wyoming Nonprofit Network. It is a fun and engaging opportunity for Friends of PAC to spend 24 hours in partnership with hundreds of other Wyoming nonprofits. Two local businesses; Teletractors and Cheeney Landscaping provided matched donations and helped us raise \$17,900! Additional thanks to the generous matched dollars from Hughes Charitable Foundation. As awareness of this day grows, Friends of PAC hopes to make this event a keystone of our fundraising initiatives. WyoGives is already on the calendar for July 12, 2023.







Duck Derby: A huge thank you to Jorgensen's for sponsoring the Great Pine Creek Duck Derby in August. Hundreds of ducks floated Pine Creek at the final concert in the Pinedale Fine Arts Council Outdoor summer series. This is an incredible event to watch, but you need not be present to participate - you may purchase ducks online starting in early April. Ducks are limited so don't miss out on your winning flock! Over \$2,200 were raised by hundreds of donors!



Volunteer Appreciation Day: The Volunteer thank you event was a great get together with fellow Friends of PAC supporters and community members! Bison's Bounty donuts were provided and we discussed the 2022 year and accomplishments, upcoming events and year-end donation opportunities. 
DONOR HIGHLIGHTS

Friends of PAC continues to strive to provide as much supplemental funding support to PAC as possible. The all volunteer board works hard to ensure donated dollars go to the mission of supporting ongoing programs and facilities at the Pinedale Aquatic Center. Because of this dedication and the many volunteer hours contributed by board members, 80% of revenue generated in 2022 directly supported the Pinedale Aquatic Center! Only 4% was used for administrative and professional contracting services. The remaining 16% was used for hosting fundraising events and general overhead expenses.



IMPACT OF FRIENDS OF PAC

Through funding support, Friends of PAC is proud to have supported the following at PAC:

- 93 Hours of enrichment instruction Comment start during Comment end summer day camp (45 hours of STEAM activities, 58 hours of special guest presentations)
- \$13,477.50 in funding for tuition assistance for summer camp
- 499 young student athletes benefited from participating in Jr Wrangler sports
- 327 youth completed swim lessons
- Purchase of STEAM supplies for programs
- Maintaining of facility and public hours for 94,766 visits.
